The Code of Virginia requires that all elected officials and specified executive staff receive FOIA training "within two months after assuming the local elected office," and thereafter additional training once every two years.  This presentation will provide a general overview of FOIA, while addressing commonly asked questions relating to public meetings and public records. A legislative update on changes to the Act proposed through the 2024 General Assembly will also be provided.
