

Public Safety Services

Benefits

- VRSA Public Safety Academy: VRSA's Public Safety Academy provides web-based training recognized by Virginia and eligible for accreditation based on local law enforcement academy approval. Additional courses designed for fire/EMS feature topics such as *Mental Health and Wellness for Firefighters, Emergency Vehicle Driving Techniques*, and more.
- Law Enforcement Liability Coverage: Protects law enforcement personnel from lawsuits arising from alleged wrongful acts, such as use of excessive force and other civil rights violations. This coverage provides defense costs as well as payment of damages. Limits are \$1 million per occurrence. Excess limits are available; following form.
- **Canine Property Coverage:** Covers replacement cost for canines when they are killed performing specific law enforcement functions, as well as veterinary treatment for injuries whenever the injury is the result of any law enforcement operation.
- **Public Safety Consulting:** Eligible members receive the benefit of our public safety specialist who can assist in the development and maintenance of policies and procedures.
- Law Enforcement Sample Policies: Sample policies on topics such as emergency response driving and use of force are available for members purchasing law enforcement liability coverage.
